Biogeochemical cycles can be categorized into two main types: global cycles and local cycles. Elements such as carbon, nitrogen, oxygen, and hydrogen are recycled through abiotic environments including the atmosphere, water, and soil. Since the atmosphere is the main abiotic environment from which these elements are harvested, their cycles are of a global nature.

Nutrient Cycles in the Environment

Water cycle, cycle that involves the continuous circulation of water in the Earth-atmosphere system. Of the many processes involved in the water cycle, the most important are evaporation, transpiration, condensation, precipitation, and runoff. The total amount of water remains essentially constant.

Elements, chemical compounds, and other forms of matter are passed from one organism to another and from one part of the biosphere to another through cycles that connect living things to the earth.

Notes: Biogeochemical Cycles (Cycles of Matter)

Cycles of matter are called biogeochemical cycles because they include both biotic and abiotic components and processes. Components that hold matter for short periods of time are called exchange pools, and components that hold matter for long periods of time are called reservoirs.
