Grignard reagents commonly are prepared by reaction of an alkyl halide (RX) with magnesium in a nitrogen atmosphere because the reagent is very reactive toward oxygen and moisture, which would cause the reagent to react with the water instead of any carbon atoms (2). Grignard reagents react with water to produce alkanes.

The Grignard reagent RMgBr is easily formed by redox reaction of an alkyl halide with magnesium metal in anhydrous diethyl ether solvent. R-Br + Mg @ RMgBr RMgBr = R + Mg2+ + Br The Grignard reagent can be viewed as an ionic species consisting of carbanion R-,with a Mg2+ counterion and an additional Br-counterion.

Discovered by the French chemist Victor Grignard, it involves the formation of a temporal organometallic compound which contains a carbon-metal bond involving a carbon atom, magnesium metal and a halogen anion (McMurry 345). Many different kinds of halides can be used in these reactions, including alkyl and vinylic chains, and aromatic rings.

The Grignard reaction is one of the most general methods for carbon-carbon bond formation in all of organic chemistry. In the first stage of this procedure, an organic halide reacts with magnesium metal to form an organomagnesium compound, which is known as a Grignard reagent.
