What is the Stella Adler Acting Method? Adler disagreed with Strasberg's interpretations and usage of Stanislavski's system, feeling that emotional recall was a psychologically unhealthy way to approach acting. When she trained with Stanislavski in 1934, she discovered that Stanislavski, too, had changed his mind about his own early concepts of emotional memory and emotional recall.
